## Morrisville Creek Week Design-a-Sticker Contest Rules

Celebrate Morrisville Creek Week by designing a sticker that shows your creativity and commitment to protecting our local waterways and environment. Winning designs will be shared with the community and used in future Creek Week events and activities!

### About Creek Week

Morrisville Creek Week is part of the [North Carolina Clean Water Education Partnership \(NC CWEP\)](#) regional initiative. It raises awareness about the importance of clean water through stream cleanups, storm drain assessments, educational booths, and hands-on activities like aquatic insect collection and water quality monitoring.

### Eligibility

Open to high school students (grades 9 through 12) and adults who live in Morrisville. High school students must have parent or guardian consent to participate.

### Sticker Design Guidelines

- Theme & Design Elements:** The selected theme is **Environmental Stewardship**. Your design should capture the spirit of Morrisville Creek Week and show how our community protects local waterways and ecosystems. Include ideas such as:
  - Clean water and water quality
  - Stream, creeks, and waterways
  - Stormwater management and pollution prevention
  - Wildlife, native plants, and healthy ecosystems
- Shape & Size:** Sticker designs must be circular, sized at **2 inches in diameter**.
- Required Text:** Include the phrase “Morrisville Creek Week” in your design.
- Media:** Both digital and hand-drawn artwork will be accepted.
  - Hand-drawn submissions must be received at Town Hall (100 Town Hall Drive) by the deadline. This submission must have the completed entry

form firmly attached to the back of the submission, written legibly (typed preferred).

- b. Digital submissions should be emailed to [tvictor@morrisvillenc.gov](mailto:tvictor@morrisvillenc.gov) along with the completed entry form as an attachment. PDF or PNG file is recommended for the sticker design.
5. **Originality:** No templates, clip art, AI-generated art, or copyrighted materials (including images, characters, logos, or brand names) may be used. Minimal to no assistance from other is encouraged to ensure originality.
6. **Limit:** Only one entry is allowed per person.
7. **Deadline:** All entries must be received by Monday, March 23, 2026, at 5 p.m.

### **Judging Procedure**

After the deadline, the Morrisville Stormwater Team will review all entries for creativity, originality, and theme relevance. One winner will be chosen from each age group: high school students and adults. Winners will be announced after Creek Week on the Town of Morrisville Stormwater social media platforms. Each winner will be contacted by Morrisville Stormwater staff and will receive a gift bag with Town swag.
